Welcome to Harrisville City! Thank you for being a part of our community. Here are a few things to know when setting up utilities.

Bona Vista Water Improvement District is the contracted provider for culinary water services in Harrisville. All utility billing services are provided through Bona Vista monthly and includes billing for culinary water services, sewer utility, storm water utility, street light utility, and garbage services. For new service connections, please contact Bona Vista Water Improvement District at (801) 621-0474 or via their website of www.bonavistawater.com.

Waste Management is the contracted provider for garbage and recycling services in Harrisville. Contact the City for new service connections or service requests. Garbage service requests can be filled out online at <https://harrisvillecity.gov/city-utilities/> or through our automated message system by calling (801) 782-4100 option 3. Secondary water services are provided by Pineview Water Systems or the Four Mile Special Service District. For service information with Pineview, contact their office at (801) 621-6555. For service within the Four Mile Special Service District please contact the City at (801) 782-4100. Harrisville is included in the Weber Basin Water Conservancy District.

CITY PARKS & BUILDINGS

City Hall and the Police Station are located at 363 Independence Blvd. Office hours are Monday - Thursday 8 am to 5 pm and Fridays 8 am to noon. Closed all major holidays.



Public Works building is currently located at 708 W 1750 N.

Parks and Recreation Building is located at 1350 N Hwy 89.

Martin Henderson Harris Bicentennial cabin located at 735 W. Harrisville Road. Reservations taken online at city website.



Harrisville City Main Park is located at 1350 N Hwy 89. There is a shared walking path about the detention basin, disc golf course, splash pad, bowery, playgrounds, and a fishing pond for residential use. Reservations for the park bowery can be made online from April to September every year. Restrooms and Splash Pad are open seasonally. Walking path distance is approx. .23 miles or 1,256 feet.

Millenium Park is located at 2000 N 550 W and is currently undergoing reconstruction. There is a walking path available. The path distance is approx. .38 miles or 2,023 feet.

Independence Park is located at 220 W Independence Blvd. There is a shared walking path. The path distance is approx. .53 miles or 2,821 feet.
