2025 Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA)

The City of Harrisville will hold a municipal election on August 12, 2025 (Primary Election) and November 4, 2025 (General Election) to elect the following offices:

- Mayor (4-year term beginning January 2026)
- Two (2) City Council Members (4-year term beginning January 2026)

Military and Overseas Voters:

If you are active-duty military member, military spouse or dependent, or a U.S. Citizen residing overseas, you are eligible to vote in Harrisville City elections under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA). You may register to vote and request a regular absentee ballot.

When using a federal write-in absentee ballot, fill out the Voter Information section completely and accurately. Write-in the office and candidate name(s) for the races you chose to vote for in the appropriate sections.

To be valid a military-overseas ballot shall be:

1. Received by the appropriate election officer not later than the close of the polls; or
2. Submitted for mailing, electronic transmission, or other authorized means of delivery not later than 12:01 AM, at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on the date of the election.
